STATEMENT OF FAITH

1. We believe the Bible to be the inspired, the only infallible, authoritative Word of God.

STATEMENT OF PRINCIPLES

BRPC is an outreach ministry of Jesus Christ through his church, Therefore, BRPC embodied in its volunteers, is committed to presenting, in both word and in deed, the gospel of Jesus Christ to women facing unintended pregnancy. Commensurate with this purpose, directors of BRPC and volunteers are expected to know Christ as their Lord and Savior.

BRPC is committed to providing its clients with the accurate and complete information about fetal development, parenting, adoption, and abortion.

BRPC is committed to integrity in dealing with clients, earning their trust, providing promised information and services, and avoiding any form of deception in its advertising or individual conversations.

BRPC recognizes and respects the fact that women have choices for their pregnancy. Therefore, we provide education and compassionate care, in order to empower her to make an informed decision regarding her pregnancy. BRPC maintains that it is the best interest of a woman to carry her baby to term and parent or make an adoption plan.

BRPC shall never discriminate in providing services because of race, creed, color, national origin, age, or marital status of its clients.

BRPC shall offer services free of charge at all times.

BRPC is committed to educating the community of the specific fears and challenges a woman faces in an unintended pregnancy. Furthermore, we are committed to raising awareness of abortion and its impact within the local community.

BRPC encourages abstinence from sexual intercourse as the most effective method of birth control and its prevention of sexually transmitted diseases. BRPC does not advocate the use of contraceptives by unmarried persons as an alternative to abstinence, and additional questions regarding contraceptives are referred to the client's medical provider or the local health department.

BRPC recognizes the validity of adoption as one alternative to abortion. BRPC is independent of adoption agencies, relating to them in the same manner as to other helpful referral sources. BRPC shall receive no payment of any kind from these agencies, nor shall it enter into contractual relationships with them or share combined office space. Adoption agencies shall not be established under the auspices of BRPC, nor shall BRPC initiate or facilitate independent adoptions.

BRPC neither condones or condemns other pro-life organizations and, should BRPC directors or volunteers exercise their right to support such organizations, such support is not representative of BRPC.

CORE VALUES

Protecting the Sanctity of Life: We are pro-life in our principles and practices and never advises, provides or refers for abortion. We educate women on all of their options in hopes they will chose life.

Christ Centered: We are an outreach ministry of Jesus Christ through His church to present the gospel of our Lord in both word and deed to women and men to make informed decisions regarding their reproductive health.

Trustworthy: We are committed to integrity in dealing with clients, earning their trust, providing accurate information and services and never discriminates because of race, religion, creed, age, or marital status.

Servanthood: We are committed to providing services at no cost to our client to save lives.
