Thank you so much for your interest and willingness to recognize Sanctity of Human Life Sunday (SOHL) during the month of January, or on January 18 (Sanctity of Human Life Sunday). We are so grateful to you and your congregation!

- **Participating in a Baby Bottle Campaign**

- **Mentoring a Pregnancy and Parenting Foundations (PPF) class or One-on-One Mentoring**

- * Each class runs for six weeks – our primary goal is to connect mentors from your church with our clients to build meaningful relationships. We are also in need of one-on-one mentors for both moms and dads.

- **Sending us advocates**

- * Encourage members of your congregation to serve as Patient Advocates. These volunteers meet with patients one-on-one, assess their needs, and share the hope of the Gospel.
