



Volunteer Male Advocate Description

Objectives of the position: As an ambassador of Jesus Christ, the Male Advocate provides Christ-centered support to men and couples facing pregnancy-related decisions while encouraging responsible fatherhood and life-affirming choices. The Male Advocate serves as a peer mentor, provides practical support and education, recruits and encourages male volunteers, and helps advance the mission of Blue Ridge Pregnancy Center through compassionate, confidential client care.

Accountability: The Male Advocate serves under the direct supervision of the Director of Men's Engagement and Media and works collaboratively with the Patient Services team.

Status: Volunteer

Minimum Qualifications:

- A committed Christian who demonstrates a personal relationship with Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord and is an active member of a local church.
- Strong commitment to the sanctity of human life and God's design for marriage and family.
- Agrees to uphold BRPC's Statement of Faith, policies, and code of conduct.
- Dependable, emotionally mature, teachable, and able to maintain confidentiality.
- Strong interpersonal communication skills with the ability to build trusting relationships.
- Successfully completes BRPC orientation, training, and any required background screening.

Major Responsibilities:

- Welcome and support male clients, fathers, partners, and couples with compassion and respect.
- Conduct approved client intakes, document interactions, and maintain accurate client records.
- Support BRPC staff by maintaining confidentiality, professionalism, and adherence to all policies.
- Provide one-on-one mentoring and facilitate approved fatherhood or parenting education.
- Make timely follow-up contacts and connect clients with appropriate BRPC resources.
- Pray with clients when appropriate and desired by the client.
- Encourage and mentor future male volunteers as requested.
- Assist with men's ministry events, outreach opportunities, and church partnerships.

- Ability to maintain healthy boundaries

Training:

- Complete all required BRPC client-care and confidentiality training.
