



Men's Engagement Coordinator Volunteer Description-Danville

Objectives of the position: As an ambassador of Jesus Christ, the Men's Engagement Coordinator Volunteer provides support for Blue Ridge Pregnancy Center's ministry to men by developing meaningful relationships with fathers, expectant fathers, and male partners while recruiting and equipping volunteers to do the same. This position helps coordinate all men's engagement initiatives, including client services, volunteer recruitment and development, fatherhood education, church partnerships, community outreach, and the Noble Pursuit men's program.

Accountability: The Men's Engagement Coordinator serves under the direct supervision of the Director of Men's Engagement and Media and works collaboratively with the Patient Services team.

Supervises: All male volunteer staff assisting the program through the Medical Clinic and Mentorship program

Status: Volunteer 15-20 hours weekly (may vary based on men scheduled to be seen)

Minimum Qualifications:

- A committed Christian who demonstrates a personal relationship with Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord and is an active member of a local church
- Exhibit a strong commitment and dedication to the pro-life position and God's design for marriage and sexuality
- Agree with and be willing to uphold the Statement of Faith, Statement of Policy, and Statement of Principal of and all other policies of the Blue Ridge Pregnancy Center
- Exhibit skills in effective interpersonal communication and organizational skills, management, teaching, public speaking, problem solving, and computer use
- Be able to provide spiritual leadership, discipleship, and support to male volunteers and clients
- Be a self-starter, able to carry out responsibilities with little or no direct supervision; exhibit strong attention to and follow-through with details; demonstrate flexibility and the ability to pivot to meet center needs

Major Responsibilities:

- Provide Christ-centered advocacy, mentorship, and ongoing support to male clients through one-on-one appointments and follow-up communication.
- Offer compassionate guidance and practical resources to help men navigate pregnancy-related decisions and embrace responsible fatherhood.
- Coordinate and facilitate fatherhood, parenting, and life-skills education using approved curricula and resources.
- Maintain accurate, timely, and confidential documentation of client interactions, appointments, referrals, and follow-up activities.
- Recruit, onboard, train, supervise, and encourage Male Advocates to ensure effective and consistent ministry to male clients.
- Develop and maintain strong partnerships with local churches and pastors to expand awareness and support for BRPC's men's ministry.
- Establish and maintain collaborative partnerships with community organizations that provide resources and support for fathers and families.
